### Uniforms:

The following outlines the uniform for the Flag Line unit and approximate cost which are required.

- Rounder's Auxiliary Shirt – approx. \$20 available before Coliseum practices
- Navy Blue Custom Made Skirt and Compression Shorts – approx. \$35
- Hose – to match your skin tone color
- Plain white sneaker Sketcher – Dream Come True style - approx.. \$30
- White Sure Grip Gloves – approx. \$6 (Lead will order) Red sequin wristbands
- White no-show socks

- No other additions to the uniform are permitted.
