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Shoes:

Our band shoes are one of the most easily "noticed" components of our uniform and so extra care needs to be taken to ensure compliance and uniformity. All band members are required to wear <u>ALL WHITE</u> sneakers with white shoelaces. Over the years, members have "stretched" the boundaries wearing white shoes with assorted colored markings. See picture #1 and #2 below for examples. These are NOT acceptable for performance. Even if the "accent" or "markings" on the sneakers are a Rounder color (navy blue, red), they are NOT acceptable. We understand that finding all white sneakers can be a challenge; in light of this, band members may wear white sneakers with light grey trim. (As shown in picture #3) Sneakers are to be clean and **WHITE.** Dirty or worn out sneakers are NOT acceptable. Please pay close attention to the shoe sole color as well. Your sneakers should look like the example on the RIGHT and NOT the example on the LEFT (as shown in picture #4)



Socks:

The official Rounders sock color is WHITE. Black, blue, brown, etc. will not be acceptable for our official uniform.

Questions:

If you have ANY questions about your band uniform, see Susan Bingham (Flute section) Please do NOT just "show up" at a performance and "hope" your uniform is in compliance. That is a formula for disaster! Show any questionable uniform components to Susan BEFOREHAND to ensure your uniform is acceptable.
